RULES AND REGULATIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

NO ENTRY FEES FOR 2020 – CONTESTS OPEN TO RESIDENTS OF MANITOBA ONLY

- To maintain social distancing - exhibitors MUST send entries and a completed form by email, facebook messenger or to the Secretary in Glenboro prior to June 15th, 2020. (Or May 15th for Class 36.) Secretary: Linda Naismith, Box 57, Glenboro, Manitoba R0K 0X0. See entry form on back page. Blank entry forms can be acquired via email - please contact glenboroagsociety@gmail.com
- All entries must be the exhibitor's property or must be the work of the exhibitor.
- All entries must be made or produced within the last year.
- Judging of most entries shall begin June 16th, 2020 at 9:00 am and conclude on June 30th, 2020 at 6:00 pm.
- For facebook contests:
Identification of entries may result in the removal of entries from the contest. In an effort to create an unbiased contest we will not identify any entries submitted while they are being voted on by the public (through "likes" on facebook). Photos may not include identifiable people.
- For independently judged contests:
In the absence of competition, the judge may award first, second or no prize, according to the merit of the exhibit and shall have it in their power to withhold any premium for any article, which they may consider unworthy of same. Judge's decision will be final.
- **Only one entry will be allowed per exhibitor in any section of a class**
- Exhibitors will please communicate any complaint or grievance regarding payments of prize money to the Treasurer within 10 days of receipt of prize money.
- Any infringement of the Rules will be punished by withdrawing the prizes, expulsion from the Society, or both.
- **ALL CHEQUES MUST BE CASHED WITHIN 60 DAYS OF RECEIPT.**
- **PRIZE MONEY will be sent in cheque form by mail – please ensure you submit your mailing address.**
- **The Glenboro Agricultural Society will endeavor not to identify winners and will not publish their names publicly except with the expressed permission of the individual (or their parent/guardian).**
