YOUTH IN PHILANTHROPY REPORT

Glenboro Area Foundation is continuing to work with Glenboro School and Spruce Woods Provincial Park on the development and maintenance of two trails in the Epinette Trail system. Progress from last year now sees the trails completely cut through, several parts leveled, the map of the new trails on the Spruce Woods Park website, and the beginning of installing signage. Immediate plans this spring include continuing with further signage being put up, some benches installed, and more leveling/clearing. The names of the trails are official now - Spruce Alternate (1km.) and Cedar Trail (4km.). The students of Glenboro School along with several community adult members have been invaluable in developing/recommissioning these beautiful nearby trails! We hope you get a chance to soon check them out, as they are now fully navigable.

30 YEARS OF GIVING BACK

- While the Glenboro Foundation was incorporated in 1987, it wasn't until 1992 that the first grants were awarded. Here are a few "30 Years of Giving Facts!"
- Grants of \$350 were awarded in 1992; value of grants, scholarships and designated funds awarded in 2022 were approximately \$88,500.
  - More than 560 grants and scholarships have been handed out over the years.
  - Major recipients include Glenboro School (over \$114,000 grants and scholarships), Health Care Auxiliary (\$102,000), Glenboro Minor Sports (\$43,800).
  - 30 individuals have received \$56,400 in health care scholarships.
  - Approximate value of 30 years of awarded grants: \$985,886!
