30 YEARS OF GIVING BACK

While the Glenboro Foundation was incorporated in 1987, it wasn't until 1992 that the first grants were awarded. Here are a few "30 Years of Giving Facts!"

- Grants of \$350 were awarded in 1992; value of grants, scholarships and designated funds awarded in 2022 were approximately \$88,500.
- More than 560 grants and scholarships have been handed out over the years.
- Major recipients include Glenboro School (over \$114,000 grants and scholarships), Health Care Auxiliary (\$102,000), Glenboro Minor Sports (\$43,800).
- 30 individuals have received \$56,400 in health care scholarships.
- Approximate value of 30 years of awarded grants: \$985,886!
