RESOLVED that the Council adopt the agenda as amended.

RESOLVED that the minutes of the last regular meeting of Council held on August 10, 2022, be taken as read and approved, all statutory requirements having been fulfilled.

RESOLVED that the Council give first reading to By-law #86 - (Mitigation and Preparedness Plan Reserve Fund).

RESOLVED that the Council approve the Internet Subsidy Provision Policy.

RESOLVED that the Council authorize the payment of fiscal year 2022 accounts from cheque #20220684 to and including cheque #20220773, as well as all ACH (online) payments, as fully detailed to Council by the Finance Manager.

RESOLVED that the Council accept as information the financial report for the period ending August 31, 2022, as presented by the Finance Manager.

RESOLVED that the property assessments as listed under Schedule "A" be added to the Municipality of Glenboro South Cypress' 2022 Assessment Roll under the authority of Section 326 (1) of the Municipal Act;

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the additional taxes thereon as set out in Schedule "B" be added to their respective property within the Municipality of Glenboro South Cypress, as added taxes for the year 2022 under the authority of Section 326 (1) of the Municipal Act.

RESOLVED that the Council approve Road Crossing Application No. RC-03-22-GSC submitted by Steve Wollman of MIBIDA Inc., for the installation of a fibre optic line within the municipal right-of-way along Municipal Road 39N crossing at Municipal Road

87W, Stockton Road, Road 88W and Right-of-Way 89W, at a 90 degree angle, subject to a Road Crossing Easement Agreement between the Applicant and Council and compliance with the Municipal Irrigation Policy.

RESOLVED that the Council request technical and financial assistance from the Manitoba Water Services Board to complete an urban and rural water system study for the Municipality of Glenboro South Cypress.

RESOLVED that the Council lobby the Federal Government to abolish the ArriveCAN app and to encourage Nexus interviews to resume.
